Abdul Dire's *Oromo Witness* receives national recognition through an Independent Press Award

Oromo Witness looks beyond history books to reveal the personal journey of one extraordinary man.

On April 16, 2021, *Oromo Witness* by Abdul Dire was recognized with an <u>Independent Press Award</u> as a <u>Distinguished Favorite</u> in the category of World History.

The competition is judged by experts from different aspects of the book industry, including publishers, writers, editors, book cover designers and professional copywriters. Selected award winners and distinguished favorites are based on overall excellence.

Oromo Witness tells the astonishing tale of Hangasu Wako Lugo, from his home in Ethiopia to his fight for his people's freedom and, finally, to St. Paul, Minnesota. Twin Cities debut author, Abdul Dire, Hangasu's nephew, takes readers on a journey of survival, resistance, triumph, internal conflict, and wisdom. Along the way, the reader will learn about the history and culture of the Oromo people and their struggle for the opportunity to determine their own destiny on their own land.

In 2021, the Independent Press Award had entries worldwide. Participating authors and publishers reside in countries such as Australia, Canada, India, Ireland, Japan, Singapore, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and others. In addition, books submitted included writers located in U.S. cities such as Atlanta to Santa Fe; Chicago to New York; from Boise to Honolulu, and others.
